Award Citation

Marine Aviation Logistics Squadron 11 demonstrated meritorious achievement in aviation logistics support to Marine Aircraft Group 11, 3d Marine Aircraft Wing from 1 May 2008 to 30 April 2009. MALS-11 excelled across the spectrum of aviation logistics support for 15 fixed-wing and rotary-wing squadrons, enabling reinforced MAG-11 to fly over 51,000 hours during this period. The Devilfish of MALS-11 supported 27 deployments, while supporting the most demanding Marine Aircraft Group operational tempo in the Marine Corps. The squadron led the way in process improvement events, continuously increasing aircraft readiness and availability. MALS-11 coordinated the implementation of organizational-level airspeed and current readiness initiatives with VMGR-352, which contributed to them becoming the first aircrew core competent unit in the Marine Corps. MALS-11 was the Marine Corps model for integrating fleet readiness center depot-level artisans and increasing availability of aeronautical parts to the flightline. Through their dedicated efforts and significant achievements, the Marines and sailors of MALS-11 have reflected great credit upon themselves and upheld the highest traditions of the Marine Corps and the United States Naval Ser
